Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Kingfisher County District 3 will receive sealed bids for bridge rehabilitation project, bridge #137 near the intersection of NS2740 and EW890 roads. Bids will be accepted at the Kingfisher County Courthouse in the Office of the County Clerk until 4:00pm on the 4th day of June, 2021 to be opened at their regular meeting of June 7th, 2021.

Statement of Work and Specifications of the project to be bid are included in the bid packet and also available from the purchasing agent located in the Kingfisher County Clerk's office and the County Engineer's office.

The successful bidder is required to produce a performance bond upon request and to show certificates of Insurance, its limits, and Workers Compensation Insurance. This will be detailed in the Statement of Work and general requirements.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids. All bidders must complete a statement of non-collusion and a Cashier's Check, a certified check, or a surety bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the gross amount of base bid as a guaranty, shall accompany the sealed proposal of each bidder. Deposits will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders and successful bidders, upon approval of the contract and submission of a 100% Performance Bond, a 100% Statutory Bond, and a 100% Maintenance Bond. Pursuant to the notice inviting proposals, the undersigned bidder herewith submits his proposal.

He declares he has carefully examined the Plans, Specifications and forms of Contract and bonds as set forth in the proceedings for:

Kingfisher County Bridge #137 rehabilitation project

and that he has reached a full understanding of everything required on said Plans and Specifications, and that he has informed himself as to the kind and quantities of various materials to be furnished and/or the nature and location of the work to be done, and all other matters affecting the work.

The undersigned bidder proposes and agrees that if his proposal is accepted, to enter into contract with the County, on forms prescribed, with approved sureties, within seven (7) days, after notice of award to execute the Contract, and to furnish to the County a satisfactory Performance and Statutory Bond in the sum of 100% of the contract price, guaranteeing the faithful performance of the work and payment of bills.

To do any extra work not covered by the following schedule of prices or stipulated lump sum price which may be ordered by the Commissioner/or designee and to accept as full compensation therefor such prices as may be agreed upon in writing by the Engineer and the Contractor in accordance with Section 108.04 of the General Provisions.

It is further agreed that the Contractor shall begin the work on the date indicated in the Notice to Proceed and to prosecute said work in such a manner as to complete all work contracted for by **120 calendar days** following the Notice to Proceed. The Notice to Proceed shall become effective within 30 calendar of the bid opening.

The Contractor shall take out and maintain public liability insurance in accordance with Section 7 of the General Provisions of the Specifications. A copy of said Specifications is now on file in the Office of the County Clerk.

Upon completion of the Contract, the Contractor shall furnish to the County a satisfactory Maintenance Bond in the amount of 100% of the final contract price, guaranteeing the maintenance of the work for a period of <u>ONE</u> (1) year after acceptance by the County.

- 4. <u>Payments to Contractor</u>. The County shall make payments to the Contractor in the following manner:
 - a. On completion of the work, but prior to the acceptance thereof by the County, it shall be the duty of the County Commissioner, or designee, to determine that said work has been completely and fully performed in accordance with this Contract and all incorporated documents; and upon making such determination, said official shall make his final certification to the County.
 - b. The Contractor shall furnish proof that all claims and obligations incurred by him in connection with the performance of said work have been fully paid and settled; said information shall be in the form of an affidavit, which shall bear the approval of the surety on the contract bonds, for payment of the final estimate to the Contractor; thereupon, the final estimate (including retainage, but less any liquidated damages), will be approved and paid, within five (5) days after the first regularly scheduled meeting of the County of the following month.
- 5. <u>Bargaining</u>. The County and the Contractor have had the opportunity to seek independent legal counsel before entering into this Contract. The language of this Contract shall be construed simply, according to its fair meaning, and not strictly for or against either party.

GENERAL NOTES

The road will be open to traffic during construction of the bridge. Raggers and advance working signs will be required at each and of the bridge construction some as shown on sheet 6. The contractor shall be responsible for placement and monitariones of all construction signs, borricodes, lights, etc. according to the standards set facth in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 2009 Edition, All cost of necessary items for construction signing will be included in the pay item Construction Traffic Control.

All construction and materials shall be in accordance with the 2009 Oklahoma Standards Specifications for Highway Construction, $\,$

Poy Item "Earthwork" is for the excevation of wings, aprons, and barrel and any apphalt necessary to access the RCE. Any apphalt that is to be removed to be sow aut. All cost of excevation shall be included in this pay Item and shall be done in accordance with Standard SBI-4-2 and Section 202,04.(c) of the Standard Specifications.

All trees, brush, and other debris that might interfere with the flow of water shall be cleaned out to the Right-of-Way line, at the bridge. All costs to be included in the "Earthwork" pay item.

All flowlines that are to be filled shall be thoroughly compacted before construction or extension of the drainage structure. All cost to be included in the "Earthwark" pay item.

If the thickness of any of the RCB's walls do not match the existing RCB then the new RCB shall be tapered over 6 inches to match the existing RCB.

In accordance with the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Prevention Act the contractor shall notify the Oklahoma One—Call System, Inc. 72 hours prior to beginning excavation. Oklahoma One—Call System, Inc. "Call Okie" 1—800—522—6543 or 811.






