#### **Specifications**

General: These specifications shall provide for the installation of the cleaning, repair and painting of the County Courthouse and the cleaning of the exterior of the County Annex located at 101 S. Main St, Kingfisher, OK. The Courthouse is to include Pressure wash exterior, paint flashing, soffits to white including double awnings in front and rooftop awnings, also the out hanging awnings, also paint tan metal wall and white metal door and frame, paint metal stair case in east parking lot white adding yellow to front lip, and handrail, including lower staircase walls and handrail. County Annex is to be pressure washed and cleaned (a lift will be needed). Bidders are responsible to make appropriate measurements for the bid proposal.

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, in accordance with the state law and the Public Competitive Bidding act of 1974, 61 Okla. Stat. §§ 101 et seq. (hereinafter collectively referred to as "state law"), the County has caused to be prepared certain plans, specifications, and other bidding documents (the "Bidding Documents") for the work hereinafter described; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with state law, the County has approved and adopted all of said Bidding Documents and has caused an Invitation to Bid to be given and advertised and has received sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor and materials for:

# Kingfisher County Courthouse-Annex Exterior Repairs, Cleaning and Painting Building

as outlined and set out in the Bidding Documents and in accordance with the terms and provisions of this Contract; and,

WHEREAS, Contractor, in response to said Invitation to Bid, has submitted to the County, in the manner and at the time specified, a sealed bid in accordance with the terms of the Bidding Documents; and,

WHEREAS, the County, in the manner provided by state law, has publicly opened, examined and canvassed the bids submitted and has determined and declared the above-named Contractor to be the lowest responsible bidder on the above described project; and,

WHEREAS, the County has duly awarded this Contract to said Contractor, for the sum named in the bid, to-wit:

#### Dollars and Cents spelled out here (\$ . ).

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, and conditions herein stated and in consideration of the mutual benefits, which will accrue to the parties, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the parties, the parties agree as follows:

1. <u>Incorporation of Bidding Documents</u>. This Contract hereby incorporates, as if fully set out herein, the Plans, Specifications, General Provisions, Special Provisions, Contractor's Proposal and any and all Addendums issued. All of these documents have been provided to and/or by the Contractor and are on file in the Office of the County Clerk. Hereinafter, these documents shall be collectively referred to as "Bidding Documents."

- 2. <u>Engagement of Contractor</u>. The County hereby engages Contractor to perform certain construction services for the benefit of the County. Contractor accepts such engagement pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein.
- 3. <u>Scope of Engagement</u>. Contractor shall, in a good and first-class, workmanlike manner, at its own cost and expense, furnish all labor, materials, tools and equipment required to perform and complete said work in strict accordance with the Bidding Documents, with the following additions and/or exceptions: (if none, so state.)

- 4. <u>Payments to Contractor</u>. The County shall make payments to the Contractor in the following manner:
  - a. On completion of the work, but prior to the acceptance thereof by the County, it shall be the duty of the County Commissioner, or designee, to determine that said work has been completely and fully performed in accordance with this Contract and all incorporated documents; and upon making such determination, said official shall make his final certification to the County.
  - b. The Contractor shall furnish proof that all claims and obligations incurred by him in connection with the performance of said work have been fully paid and settled; said information shall be in the form of an affidavit, which shall bear the approval of the surety on the contract bonds, for payment of the final estimate to the Contractor; thereupon, the final estimate (including retainage, but less any liquidated damages), will be approved and paid, within five (5) days after the first regularly scheduled meeting of the County of the following month.
- 5. <u>Bargaining</u>. The County and the Contractor have had the opportunity to seek independent legal counsel before entering into this Contract. The language of this Contract shall be construed simply, according to its fair meaning, and not strictly for or against either party.
- 6. <u>Third Party Beneficiaries</u>. Nothing in this Contract, expressed or implied, is intended to confer upon any person other than the parties hereto and their respective assigns, any rights or remedies under or by reason of this Contract, except as provided expressly herein.
- Notices. Whenever a notice is required to be given in writing and under the terms of this Contract, or any extension hereunder, such notice shall either be hand-delivered or mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, and directed to the respective parties at the following addresses:

or at such other address as a party shall specify by like notice to the other party hereto. Notices shall be effective on the date of delivery.

- 8. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Contract may be executed in any number of counterparts, and when each party has signed and delivered to the other at least one (1) such counterpart, each counterpart shall be deemed an original, and when taken together with other signed counterparts, shall constitute one (1) agreement; provided, however, this Contract shall not be binding upon the parties hereto until signed by all of the parties.
- 9. <u>Integration and Amendments</u>. This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and may not be amended, altered, modified or changed in any way except in writing signed by all parties to this Contract and which specifically references this Contract. There are no other agreements, representations or warranties, whether oral or written, regarding the subject matter of this Contract. No course of dealings involving the parties hereto and no usage of trade shall be relevant or admissible to interpret, supplement, explain or in any way vary any of the terms expressly set forth in this Contract. Any amendment to this Contract shall be attached to this Contract and all of the terms in this Contract not addressed in the amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
- 10. <u>Binding Effect</u>. This Contract binds the parties and any successors and assigns of the parties.
- 11. <u>Severability</u>. If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses, or parts be held invalid for any reason, the invalidity of such section, sentence, clause, or part shall not affect nor prejudice the applicability and validity of any other provision of this Contract.
