Bids will be accepted at the Kingfisher County Courthouse in the Office of the County Clerk until 4:00pm on the 14th day of August 2026, to be opened at their regular meeting of August 17th, 2026.

The successful bidder is required to produce a Bid bond, Maintenance bond, Statutory bond, Performance bond upon request and to show Certificates of Insurance, its limits, and Workers Compensation Insurance.

Specifications of the fencing required are included in the bid packet located online at Kingfisher.okcounties.org under the bids tab and also available from the purchasing agent located in the Kingfisher County Clerk's office.

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SCOPE OF WORK

** Specifications **

Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and materials necessary to complete the following work.

1. INSTALLATION OF NEW FENCE

- Install approximately 3,900 linear feet of 7'-0" tall galvanized chain-link fence utilizing 9-gauge galvanized fabric.
- Fence shall include three (3) strands of barbed wire mounted on 45-degree barb arms.
- Posts shall be set in concrete in accordance with industry standards and project requirements.
- Fence shall be constructed plumb, true, and in a professional manner.

2. GATE WORK

- Contractor shall reuse Owner's existing 1 double bi-parting cantilever gates (40ft opening). Contractor to install 1 new double bi-parting cantilever gate (40ft opening). Exact gate locations to be confirmed on site with owner.
- Existing gates shall be removed, reset, adjusted, and reinstalled as required for proper operation. Modify existing gates to accommodate 3 strands barbed wire to match new fence style
- Contractor shall make reasonable adjustments necessary to ensure gates operate correctly upon completion.

3. DEMOLITION AND DISPOSAL

- Contractor shall demolish and remove existing barbed wire field fencing as necessary to facilitate installation of the new fence.

Limits of existing to be removed to be confirmed on site with owner, not to exceed 3800LF

- Contractor shall haul away and legally dispose of all demolished fencing materials generated by Contractor's work.

4. OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Owner shall remove all existing steel H-braces prior to Contractor's installation of new fence.
