

KINGFISHER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

February 17, 2026

Minutes of the regular meeting of Kingfisher County Board of County Commissioners was held on February 17, 2026. Advanced notice of the meeting was posted on bulletin board next to the Commissioner's office and the north entrance on February 13, 2026 at 9:00 am.

1. Chairman Mike Sparks called the meeting to order at 9:00am with Commissioners Sparks leading the flag salute. Roll call was read with the following responses: Moss – absent; Sparks – present; Schwarz – present.
2. Guest: Gary Reid, Kingfisher Times & Free Press; Aaron Pitts, Sheriff; Maitland Woody, All About Network; John Gooden, Citizen; Kelly Buck, Citizen; Blake Barnes, Haskell Lemon; Jeff Smith, Atlas Paving; Nik Smith, Engineer; and Emily Lee, County Clerk.

Public Comment: Jeff Smith with Atlas Paving stated with regards to point 3 on the agenda today regarding the overlay in districts 1 & 3 Bid# 8-25-26 opened on January 12th, tabled until January 20th for review, given to Haskell Lemon who is the third bidder over me Atlas Paving for an additional approximately \$200,000.00 citing my poor performance history in public record. Two weeks ago on February 2nd, I was told this was in reference to a job from July 2023, five miles long NS 270 in district 3. Citing failed asphalt that looked dry and that residents would gladly pay an extra \$200,000.00 to have been better. Not only was this project not Atlas Paving's job, thereby voiding why we were skipped originally, but on this five-mile project you had issues based on test results from CED 8 on two of fifty of the lots. That's about 1,000 ft. I guess on a \$2million job that's a deduction of \$4,194.92. After meeting two weeks ago, I got coffee from Strange Brew and went out to see this job. I took a 6-minute video of it and I can tell you that job is immaculate, with the exception of maybe 250ft, but the failed tests and reference in that meeting two weeks ago, the failure was due entirely to compaction only, which is a failure on the contractor's part not the asphalt itself. So, any reference to it being dry or thinking that it looked dry, CED 8 would determine that the asphalt was actually optimal. Gathering this information took me about thirty minutes. I could have done this for you in the eight days of deliberation, but I don't know that you would think that deep or called and we could have helped you out there. In closing two weeks ago, I was asked if I would use a carpenter who had done a poor job for me in the past and I'll actually answer that question just the way Jesus would, another carpenter. I'd say, if it was proven without a shadow of a doubt, that you had misjudged that carpenter, do you have the integrity to own your mistake and the fortitude to fix it. With that, I'd urge the County to resend their award to Haskell Lemon on that project and award to us, the rightful low bidder to the tune of saving the County \$219,000.00. Commissioner Sparks thanked Mr. Smith for his comments.

5. A motion was made by Sparks and seconded by Schwarz to Table Environmental Officer Grant with John Gooden providing information to Board until Next week.


