

KINGFISHER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

July 27, 2026

Minutes of the regular meeting of Kingfisher County Board of County Commissioners was held on July 27, 2026. Advanced notice of the meeting was posted on bulletin board next to the Commissioner's office and the north entrance on July 24, 2026 at 9:00 am.

1. Chairman Mike Sparks called the meeting to order at 9:00am with Commissioners Sparks leading the flag salute. Roll call was read with the following responses: Moss – present; Sparks – present; Schwarz – present.
