

KINGFISHER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

August 18, 2025

Minutes of the regular meeting of Kingfisher County Board of County Commissioners was held on August 18, 2025. Advanced notice of the meeting was posted on bulletin board next to the Commissioner's office and the north entrance on August 15, 2025 at 9:00 am.

1. Chairman Anthony Schwarz called the meeting to order at 9:00am with Commissioners Sparks leading the flag salute. Roll call was read with the following responses: Moss – present; Sparks – present; Schwarz – present.

Comments from the Public: Cyndi Ice- Gave a statement to the Commissioners on erosion along NS 2860 Road within District 1 and her concern about heavy and unsafe traffic in this area. Cyndi mentions the erosion issues being caused by inadequate drainage. Mrs. Ice mentioned she was given a copy of the H&H Study from CED#8 with options to address her concerns; however, she rejected this report, stating she didn't feel as if it would fix the issue.

Dorothy Hallock- Mrs. Hallock came to voice her concerns of cottonwood trees blocking the view at the road for traffic to be seen, beside Lu Greg-She stated that this issues was resolved prior to coming to the meeting today as the county had taken care of the obstruction of view.

3. Discussion regarding erosion along NS 2860 Road within District 1, was address after Cydni Ice voiced her concerns to the County. Commissioner Moss has had OKIE come out and mark utility lines in this area and offered possible solution to work on this drainage in this area. His concern was that this could possibly cause other issues with drainage as this area of concern is also downhill. He assured Mrs. Ice that he would continue to work in this area on a solution to help address the issues. As for the traffic in this area Sheriff Pits said he and his deputies are aware of the high truck traffic in this area and he would mention this concern to his deputies to continue patrolling this area.


