**Designating Bridge CN051 be named the Commissioner Keith Schroder Memorial Bridge**

WHEREAS, Keith Schroder served as Kingfisher County District #3 Commissioner from 1999 to 2019.

WHEREAS, over that 20-year period, Commissioner Schroder constructed 35 new bridges and replaced 20 other small bridge structures with large culvert pipes, thus replacing and/or improving those structurally deficient or functionally obsolete structures in the county bridge inventory.

WHEREAS, Commissioner Schroder placed bridge CN051, as a part of the County 5-year construction plan, in the County Improvements for Roads and Bridges (CIRB) Plan for new construction.

WHEREAS, Commissioner Schroder retired from county government before his last bridge project could be fully realized through the CIRB plan.

WHEREAS, bridge CN051 should stand as a testament to the dedication Commissioner Schroder exemplified for 20-years improving the road and bridge infrastructure in District #3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Kingfisher County, in recognition of Commissioner Schroder's dedication, approve designating bridge CN051 be named Commissioner Keith Schroder Memorial Bridge.
